

COMPARE THE ADVANTAGES & DISADVANTAGES OF

EXAMPLE: The Difference between a Big Car and a Little Car

A big car has the advantage that you can take your family in it and it also has a large boot to put your luggage in. A small car doesn't have these advantages. In a city street, a small car can be parked more easily than a large car, as it will fit into a smaller space. A big car can use a lot of fuel, e.g., does 40 miles to the gallon (17 km to the litre) of petrol. Whereas, a small car can be much more economical to run and may do 60 miles to the gallon. A big car is often safer than a small car because it has a larger and stronger body.

A small car is less comfortable than a big car because it has less space inside and it can be more dangerous, especially at high speeds because it's more easily affected by high crosswinds than a larger car. It's also more dangerous in an accident because there's less protection for the driver and passengers. However, a small car is usually cheaper to buy than a large car.
