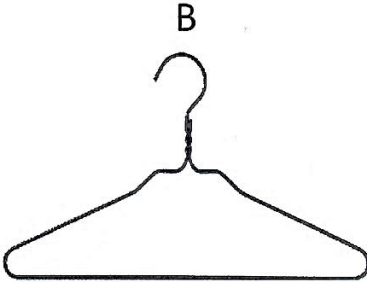
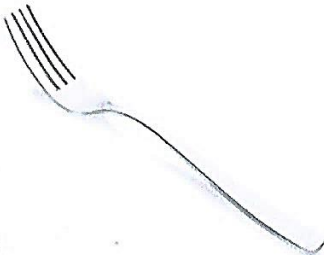
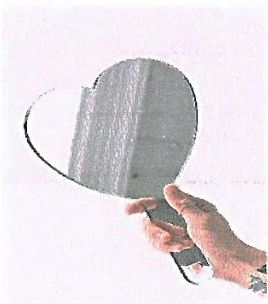


USES OF EVERYDAY OBJECTS
